### What Devices Can I Control?

The four mode keys arched across the top of the remote tell the remote which device you want to operate.

Each mode key is associated with different types of devices. You can use each mode key to control **one** of its associated devices:

Mode Key		Associated Devices
STB	STB	IP gateway STB
TV	TV	TVs

#### **Device Control**

QOWEP (D)	Turns devices <b>ON/OFF</b>
STB	Enables <b>SET TOP BOX</b> mode functions

Enables **TV** mode functions

# **DVR. On-Demand Control**







PLAYS On-Demand or recorded content

Scrolls through available **TV/VIDEO** input sources

BACK rewinds 7 seconds, and SKIP advances 30 seconds

**ON-DEMAND** accesses the On-Demand menu

## **Viewing & Browsing Control**

Accesses the **PHONE MENU** 

Accesses the INTERACTIVE PROGRAM GUIDE (IPG)

Views **LIVE TV** 

MOVES through selections

SELECTS and DESELECTS screen items

CLEARS all menu screens and returns to broadcast TV

Accesses the **SEARCH** menu for Scientific Atlantic/Cisco STB

Accesses the **SEARCH** menu for Pace STB

Displays text **INFORMATION** about the selected programs

Displays or closes the program **GUIDE** 

Selects the next channel, **UP** or **DOWN**, when

JUMPS to next section or switches to last channel

watching TV; Moves **UP** or **DOWN** one page in the program guide and in some menu screens

### **Sound Control**

JUMP

Note: These keys are assigned to the TV when the TV mode key is programmed with a valid code.

Adjusts **VOLUME** 

MUTES sound (may not operate on some TVs)

# Numeric Keys

0 0

Enter channel numbers (**0-9**), text and remote codes; also use to enter your parental control PIN

also use to enter your parental control PII

CLEARS text and numbers in text fields

ENTERS and SAVES (stores) an entry
